## **DO YOU QUALIFY?**



If you are a customer of an electricity utility and in a lower-income home, you may qualify for a reduction on your electricity bill through the Ontario Electricity Support Program (OESP).

### YOU COULD RECEIVE **A CREDIT ON YOUR ELECTRICITY BILL**

Beginning in 2016, the OESP will reduce the cost of your household electricity by applying a monthly credit directly to your bill.

### WHAT SUPPORT **COULD YOU RECEIVE?**

The amount of the credit you could receive depends on two factors:

- How many people live in your home and
- Your combined household income

To help address some of the unique challenges that can lead to higher electricity use and costs in many communities, the OESP provides a higher level of support to lowerincome First Nations households.

For example, a home with four people and an annual household income of \$39.000 can receive an on-bill credit of \$50 each month.
