

Waasigan Transmission Line Project Environmental Assessment Field Team Members

Field Team Members are needed on a short-term contract basis to assist with fish, wildlife, vegetation and surface water field surveys in support of the Waasigan Transmission Line Project Environmental Assessment. Golder Associates Ltd., a member of WSP (WSP Golder), is looking to hire Field Team Members to work alongside WSP Golder biologists and environmental specialists as a part of our Project Team.

Location, Schedule and Hours

These positions are expected to be one to two weeks in duration within the spring and summer of 2022. Depending on the number of interested participants, applicants may be able to participate in multiple field programs throughout the 2022 field season. Field days are expected to be approximately 10 to 12-hour days. Field work will require travelling with the Project Team by truck, ATV/UTV, helicopter, boat and by foot within the Project study area and require out of town accommodations. All out of town travel costs, including meals and overnight accommodations for the Field Team Members, will be arranged and paid for by WSP Golder. As a part of the hiring process, you will be required to review and acknowledge WSP Golder policies and procedures, and participate in our health and safety training and on-the-job training, as required, over the course of these contracts.

Duties

Under the direction of WSP Golder's biologists and environmental specialists, Field Team Members may be responsible for:

- Taking field measurements using field equipment and recording field observations
- Assisting with field equipment preparation, calibration and maintenance while in the field
- Hiking with equipment from the truck, ATV/UTV, helicopter or boat to survey sites
- Working in or near waterbodies
- Working in inclement weather conditions
- Being involved in Health and Safety meetings and discussions, and implementing safe practices

Desired Skills and Education

The ideal person(s) for this job will:

- Have an interest in working in the outdoors
- Be able to hike across rough terrain carrying basic gear
- Be able to stay with the team for the full duration of the one to two week assignments
- Be able to write and document field observations
- Have good communication skills (English required)
- Have a good attitude for Health and Safety

Rate will be \$25/hour. Time and expenses for travel as well as accommodation and food during the contract will be provided, if staying away from home.
