- Reading the measuring instruments and metres in order to record the readings and quantifying the goods loaded and drawn
- Documenting the required and important readings and quantities of the truck and commodities respectively in the driver's log
- Examining the goods and ensuring that they meet all policies, rules, and regulations
- Have a valid Class G license and clean driving record
- Working around heavy equipment
- Physically fit with the ability to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.
- Able to work a minimum 20 days on with 8 days off in remote locations
- Potential to working longer shifts may be required
- Ability to work in a team
